




NEGES Y MAER

If you have any questions/ideas/suggestions to improve our town then please get in touch. I am really excited to be on this journey with you .



Poppy Cascade at Gwrych Castle

Remembering the Fallen, Gwrych Castle
Trust has been inspired to work on a Poppy
Cascade, a lasting memorial and a symbol
of Hope, Remembrance and Respect and to
remember all those who have fallen during
various conflicts and more recently

COVID. It is also to remember the Jewish Refugees from "Operation
Kindertransport" during WW2 who lived happily and safely at the Castle who
had lost their families and friends in Europe.

A dedicated team of volunteers led by Beryl Walton, the Assembly Manager
for the project, have crafted and assembled thousands of individual poppies,
each and every one holding a meaning to its maker. The appeal reached 'Knitters'
and 'Crafters' and their families throughout the town and surrounding areas, poppies have been received
from several parts of the UK, overseas, even as far as Australia !!

The Cascade will be on display at St Michael's Parish Church for the Remembrance period. During the
winter months more poppies will be added for display at Tŵr Gobaith, the Tower of Hope at
Gwrych Castle at Easter.

The project, which supports the Royal British Legion, will continue reaching out to local
schools giving younger people a deeper understanding of our local heritage and the value
of treasuring those we have lost whilst remembering the past.

Canolfan Dewi Sant Centre, Pensarn is an innovative multi-purpose modern community venue in Pensarn, Abergel. It comprises of St. David's Church, a very large main function hall, committee room, bistro room and kitchen. All of these rooms are available to be hired out at very competitive rates by third sector organisations, local government, support and community groups, charities and businesses. The rooms are all different sizes from one another and are suitable for meetings, training events, one to one work, support sessions, well-being sessions and so much more. There is a private car park with 15 spaces to the rear of the building. For those using public transport, the nearest bus stops are just two minutes' walk away and the Pensarn train station is five minutes away. The Centre is close to the A55 - a perfect location for easy access for those travelling from across North Wales.

The Volunteers and Staff of Canolfan Dewi Sant Centre have worked extremely hard since March 2020 to ensure the Centre is Covid Secure. The health and safety of every person who enters the Centre is paramount to us.

Abergel Men's Shed

Like all other social groups and businesses we have endured a challenging time, it has been difficult but we haven't been idle. Members of the Abergel Men's Shed have been very busy.

We have received planning permission to develop and renovate the building at the rear of 35 Market Street (rear of St Kentigern and A J Chip Shop). We have cleared out approximately 30 tons of dumped rubbish and the remains of the roof and first floor. We have applied to the Charity Commission to be registered as a Charity. Plans have been submitted and approved for a Men's shed with room for a community hub.

Our only setback is that we have to prematurely leave our current 'home' at Itaca. We are in the process of applying to various grantors to enable us to realise our ambition to provide a community hub in the Town Centre. We would like through this Newsletter to invite any group that may be interested in helping us to achieve our ambitious task, to contact us and see the plans and make suggestions that would benefit their aims or ambitions in the years to come. 
