With new residential developments now well under way, I would like to welcome all new residents and businesses to our lovely town and hope you will enjoy living/working in our community and all it has to offer.







Thanks to Abergele Bowling Club, local man Iain Runcie is proving that even losing your eyesight is not a barrier to enjoying sport.

Iain was 25 when he was diagnosed with retinitis pigmentosa, leading to a gradual deterioration of his eyesight.

Last year he retired as Abergele Golf Club's resident professional and today his field of vision is tiny, but he is still active on the golf course and bowling green.

His team in the town's bowls club give him all the support he needs, including appointing another member, wearing a high-vis jacket, to indicate where the jack is.

"It's incredible how supportive the club is and in fact everyone in the bowls community" says Iain, age 61.




CLWB RYGBI ABERGELE

A new pilot scheme PATHWAYS TO BETTER HEALTH was launched at the Abergele branch of the British Red Cross in July.

The British Red Cross has launched a pilot scheme in NorthWales to help people build independence and better links with their communities and reduce unnecessary hospital admissions. The move comes thanks to a £84,460 grant from North Wales Freemasons, through the Masonic Charitable Foundation.

The 'Pathways to Better Health' service aims to help over-50s in Conwy and Denbighshire who have been identified as needing extra support due to a pattern of frequent hospital attendance or calls to the emergency services.

The project will help people who call 999 or go to emergency departments (ED) more than 12 times a year, many of whom are among the most vulnerable members of our communities with few alternative sources of help. They may have multiple, complex needs including loneliness, social isolation or drug and alcohol dependency issues.
