Why can't we just hug a tree?

It's so much simpler!

This is the new language we all have to learn, but the good news is we can still hug a tree (if that's your thing!) The difficulty is applying that language to our deeds and incorporating them into our lifestyle in general. When you see Australia on fire do you feel like it's beyond anything you could do to change things? What could you possibly do to make a difference? Well, it starts with the small stuff.

The Conwy and Denbighshire Public Service Board has developed a Community Green Pledge initiative which identifies 5 Green Pledges that organisations, community groups and individuals can make to reduce their impact on the environment. Each pledge includes suggestions, guidance and opportunities for funding on projects which really can make a difference.

This scheme is free and open to anyone to join - such as community groups, sports clubs, villages, towns, charities, businesses and social enterprises.

For example one of Abergele Town Council's pledges is to reduce paper waste. All Councillors have an iPad and they now receive all their meeting documents by e-mail. This is a major reduction of paper consumption by approx. 90 reams per year on just the statutory meetings.

Cynllun Lleoliad Abergele

Mae Pwyllgor Cynllun Lleoliad yn parhau i weithio at hyrwyddo'r ardal ar gyfer y gymuned, ac yn amcanu at reoli'r defnydd a'r datblygu o dir, a'r cysylltiadau i bolisiau cynllunio a luniwyd gan Gyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy. Mae'r Cyngor wedi prynu 'Byrddau-codi-ysbwriel 2 funud', un i Barc Pentre Mawr a'r llall ar bromenâd Pensarn.

Mae'r Cyngor wedi derbyn cyllid ar gyfer swydd Hyfforddwr Cynllun Lleoliad, sydd ar hyn o bryd yn cael ei hysbysebu. Mae'r swydd yn gontact tair blynedd a gyllidir gan Gwynt y Môr, Rhyl Flats, Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy a Chyngor Tref Abergele. Mae'r Cyngor wedi ymrwymo hefyd i gyllido prosiect Cymraeg gyda Menter Iaith, a oedd i fod i gychwyn yn union cyn dechrau'r Covid 19. Fe fydd hwn yn ail-gychwyn cyn gynted ag y bydd y sefyllfa'n caniatáu.



Abergele Place Plan

The Place Plan Committee continues to work towards enhancing the area for the Community and aims to manage the use and development of land and links to planning policies set out by Conwy County Borough Council. As part of this scheme the Council has purchased '2 Minute litter pickup boards', one will be located in Pentre Mawr park and the other will be on Pensarn promenade.

The Council have also received funding for a post of a Place Plan Facilitator. The post is a three year contract funded by Gwynt y Mor, Rhyl Flats, Conwy County Borough Council and Abergele Town Council. The Committee have also committed to fund a Welsh language project with Menter Iaith, which was due to commence just before the Covid 19 pandemic took off. This will recommence as soon as the current situation allows.

Dodrefn Stryd



Yn 2020 fe brynnodd y Cyngor, gyda grant Llywodraeth Cymru a'r Cyngor Sir, wyth plannwr ychwanegol yn y Ganolfan Gymuned, y Llyfrgell ac ardal maes parcio'r Llyfrgell. Fel rhan o gynllun hefyd mae'r Cyngor wedi prynu wyth mainc newydd ar gyfer y dref, ynghyd ag wyth mainc bicnic ac wyth plannwr i'w defyddio gan y cyhoedd, ac i gymhell defnydd o ardaloedd awyr agored yn ystod y pandemig.

Street Furniture

During 2020 the Council through a Welsh Government and County Council grant purchased an additional eight planters located in the Community Centre, Library and Library Car Park area. The Council also purchased as part of this scheme eight new benches for the town and eight picnic benches for public use to encourage the use of outside space during the Pandemic.



Y Mwnt

Mae'r Mwnt sydd wedi ei leoli ger Afon Gele y tu ôl i'r siopau yn Stryd-y-Bont yn grair pwysig o dirwedd yr Oesoedd Canol yn dyddio'n ôl i'r 1300au. Cyngor Tref Abergele yw ei warcheidwad ac yn gyfrifol am gynnal a thorri gwair y Mwnt, sy'n cyfrannu'n helaeth tuag at y syniad o leoliad.

Mae Cyngor y Dref ar hyn o bryd yn siarad gyda CADW a CPAT ynglŷn â chloddio'r ardal ac â gwneud arolwg daearegol newydd ar y safle. Fe gaiff y cyhoedd fwy o wybodaeth am hyn yn 2021/2022.

The Mount

The Mount located near the river Gele behind the shops on Bridge Street, is an important relic of the medieval landscape dating back to the 1300's. Abergele Town Council is the custodian of this land and is responsible for the maintenance and mowing of the area, which contributes greatly to a sense of 'place'.

The Town Council are in talks with CADW and CPAT for the area to be excavated and for a new geological survey to be carried out on the site. Further information on this will be shared with the public in 2021/22.

Colofnau Lamp Treftadaeth

Mae Cyngor y Dref wedi cytuno gyda Chyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy i gyfrannu i gynllun i adnewyddu'r colofnau lamp ar Ffordd Llanfair, a disgwylir y bydd y gwaith hwn wedi ei gwblhau erbyn diwedd y flwyddyn ariannol bresennol

Heritage Lamp Columns

The Town Council agreed to contribute to a scheme, in conjunction with Conwy County Borough Council, to renew the lamp columns on Llanfair Road and the work is to be completed by the end of this financial year.

Cynnal llwybrau troed

Yn 2018/19 fe ymunodd Cyngor y Dref gyda Chynllun Cynnal Llwybrau Troed Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy a dynodi pedwar llwybr troed i dderbyn cynhaliaeth amserol er budd y cerddwr awyr agored. Fe barhaodd y cynllun hwnnw i 2020/21.

Footpaths Maintenance

In 2018/19 the Town Council joined the CCBC Footpaths Maintenance Scheme and nominated four footpaths to receive timely maintenance for the benefit of outdoor walkers. This scheme continued in 2020/21 and was vital to the wellbeing of the public during lockdown.

Cyfleusterau Cyhoeddus

Yn nes ymlaen fe fydd y Cyngor yn ceisio dod â'r hen floc toiled ym Mharc Pentre Mawr i'w ail-ddefnyddio eto gyda chyfleusterau modern. Public Conveniences

Abergele Town Council is currently in negotiations with CCBC to take over the ownership of two Public Conveniences in the town. The toilets on Pensarn Prom and Water Street could transfer into the management of the Town Council subject to funding and some refurbishment by CCBC. At a later stage the Council will be seeking to bring the old toilet block in Pentre Mawr Park back into commission with modern facilities. At the end of 2020 the Council resolved to Declare a Climate Emergency, this will mean that the Council will work towards ensuring that every element of the work of the Council will consider the climate and the impact that it has from its behaviour. 'I'm a Celebrity'

In 2020 the Town had the privilege to host the ITV hit programme 'I'm a Celebrity' at Gwrych Castle. This has put Abergele on the map and the Town hopes to that this legacy will raise the profile of the Town for future years.

As part of the overall scheme to enhance the Town, the Council funded the lighting of the Towers at Gwrych Castle Gates, and contributed £8000 to the purchase of the bugs, ghosts, and other features are around the Town. The Contribution also went towards the 'Local Celebrity' images located at the Pensarn shelters.

Pensarn promenade lights

The Town Council applied again to Gwynt y Mor and Rhyl Flats for grant funding towards the installation of light strings on the Promenade at Pensarn. Thanks are due to the many local residents for writing letters of support for this project.

The full cost of the installation was granted and it is hoped that the lights will be installed and fully operational by the end of March.



THE 2 MINUTE FOUNDATION

The 2 Minute Foundation is

a registered charity that is devoted to cleaning up the planet 2 minutes at a time. It believes that simple, achievable acts can add up to make a great difference. By September 2015, the amount of litter collected on monthly clean ups in Bude, Cornwall was reduced by 61% compared with the same period in the year previously. Since then over 800 beach clean, street clean and litter pick stations form a network of litter picking stations that make it easier for people to take action against litter. Each station has a Guardian, who is responsible for its day to day management.

Abergele Town Council has purchased a beachclean station for Pensarn Prom and a litterpick station for Pentre Mawr Park. As soon as it is practicable to put them out when restrictions are lifted they will be found near Pantri Bach and Abergele Rugby Club Pavilion respectively. The boards are complete with litterpicker gloves and bags for the public to use for litterpicking in short bursts of time. They can also take part in the national social media network which aims to monitor how much of a difference the 2minute litterpick will make.

The pandemic dealt a huge blow to Abergele Bowling Club last year, with all matches cancelled and the club having to rely on the generous support of members to carry out essential maintenance. But 2021 offers hope of a fresh start.

"Most of our members paid their annual subscription and that allowed us to weather the worst of the storm - in fact we even recruited some new members," said Club Treasurer Dave Potts.
