Events Meeting

15th January 2024

Meeting with Clerk and Ken from RBL 19/12/23

The Clerk requested a meeting with Ken and Rev Kate following the Remembrance Service held on Sunday 12th November 2023. Rev Kate was unable to attend.

Matters arising:

Parade was scheduled to gather at 9:30am and commence at 9:45am. Parade commenced at 9:30am due to rain and the band stating that it would interfere with the instruments.

Ken stated that he took the decision due to the band's concern for their equipment. The Clerk explained that some children missed the parade and the arrival at the Church left a long wait outside and members who would normally parade into the church, went to sit down early due to the cold.

Ken took this on board and stated that there may not be a band next year due to cost. The Clerk stated that she felt that the Council would like a marching band and asked what the Council could do to assist with this. The Clerk offered an application form to Ken to submit for a grant. An approximate cost will be around £450

The buffet after the event was discussed and Ken stated that the George & Dragon are to provide a free buffet and drink for 2024. The Clerk said that if RBL need assistance to fund the buffet then the Council could consider a grant or funding directly. The Town Council if requested could also consider funding the marching band.

The set off time was discussed and was agreed that the 9:45 set off time would continue for 2024.

Ken also stated that it has been difficult to engage with the local cadets to attend and it was agreed that the Town Hall would contact them on their behalf. Ken to forward details.

The number of children in the parade was discussed and it was agreed to double check with Rev Kate.

The Armistice Day was discussed as the Mayor was unaware that this event took place. The Clerk informed Ken that the Town Council were never involved or invited to the event on the 11th and it was more of an informal gathering. Ken agreed to inform the Council in future years. The location of the gathering was discussed as the location in the road on Market Street was not the safest place to gather and stop traffic.

Fireworks Debrief 2023

Clerk and Deputy Clerk had a meeting with Judith Sharpe and Rhian Wood on 22nd December 2023

The Health and Safety briefing will need to be conducted earlier for future events – it has to be delivered in person.

The security plan for future fireworks events will be shared. This will detail the positions of security staff as Members had remarked that security were not always visible.

The gap between the two events could be shortened to cut down on waiting times – perhaps restrict this to 30 minutes.

Many people said that they did not carry cash for donations and it may be worth considering having some card readers for the 2024 event.

It was felt that overall the event flowed nicely and was well organised.

A draft budget from CCBC costs for the 2024 Fireworks is attached.

Report from the Deputy Clerk

Beach of Dreams 2025

Clerk and Deputy Clerk attended an online meeting on 29 November 2023 regarding Beach of Dreams 2025 (https://beachofdreams.org/).

Beach of Dreams is due to take place in May 2025 and should involve walking, talking, or making activities as part of a collective moment of reflection and action regarding the climate crisis.

The current cost is £175+ VAT to register, which would include a bespoke silk pennant. The registration deadline is 1st October 2024.

It is currently unclear what future costs or time demands would be involved following registration. It is also unclear how we would tie in with events at a County level. As of 29th November only Bay of Colwyn Town Council had registered.

Further meetings will take place to gauge wider interest in the scheme where hopefully more detail will be provided.

Christmas Lighting/Trees Report

Majority of lighting issues rectified quickly by Festive and Mega, however there was an ongoing issue with the tree lights at St. Paul's Church with disagreement/confusion over where the electrical fault lies.

Reindeer motif was damaged beyond repair and had to be removed following a weekend of high winds, it was not clear if the weather or vandalism was to blame.

There were issues with the installation of the rootball trees with this being delayed until w/c 11th December. Further issue due to strong winds uprooting the tree on Sea Road (subsequently replanted by Cllr. Wood).

Negative feedback from Bodtegwel residents regarding the rootball tree. An article also appeared on the Daily Post website on 23rd December 2023.
