I refer to the above and wish to inform you that the works noted will be undertaken between Monday 15th of April and Wednesday 17th of July 2024.

All closures will be implemented overnight between the hours of 19:00 and 07:00, with exact closure times varying between the hours of 19:00 and 07:00 depending on locations and dates.

This could result in a higher than usual level of noise at intervals and I take this opportunity to apologise in advance for any inconvenience incurred.

Currently, 'Please drive carefully' and advisory speed restriction will be erected along diversion routes as mitigation where deemed required.

Additional information

Liaison with Welsh Government Orders Branch regarding Traffic Orders has been undertaken.

Co-ordination with NMWTRA and Local Authority Streetworks Managers regarding all aspects of the works (including suitability of diversion route) has been undertaken.

Full consideration has been given to the impact of the work on road users, residents and work force e.g. Type of temporary traffic management (Full road closures with local diversions, contra flow, lane closures etc. road space, date of works, time of works, other works etc.)

Information signs will be erected prior to the works advising the travelling public of the closure dates and times.

NMWTRA will distribute a letter to properties alongside the works area informing residents / businesses.

Co-ordination with National Highways / UK Highways has been undertaken to ensure no other closures are being planned on neighbouring Trunk Road networks.

Report from the Deputy Clerk

The "I'm A Celebrity..." bug sculptures are waiting to be put in for auction. Cllr Nick Williams is currently storing the sculptures at no cost to Abergele Town Council whilst awaiting a date for listing from the auctioneer.

"I'm A Celebrity..." is broadcast during November and December annually and it would be reasonable to assume that these months are when there would be greater public interest. Rumours of suspected participants for the series usually start in October. The auctioneer had a conversation with Cllr N. Williams where he stated his plan would be to begin with lead-in advertising over the summer, with a view to listing for auction when interest may have picked up. Cllr N. Williams has said he is happy to continue storing the bug sculptures until they are placed in to auction.

It was resolved to use the current auctioneer at the GP&P meeting 9th February 2023.
