Hi Ryan,

I suppose there are 3 different aspects to consider namely;

1. Columns (lamp posts etc.) with an electrical supply
2. Sign posts without an electrical supply
3. Visibility railing and bollards

In respect of 1, you would need to speak to Street Lighting street.lighting@conwy.gov.uk to better understand legislative requirements (I'm pretty sure you need a qualification to work on anything that has an electric feed direct from the mains).

In regards to 2 & 3, whilst we have no identified funding for these works, we would not be against ATC undertaking some painting works. There is no specific qualification required however for working on County assets we would expect sight of RAMS and PL insurance certification (minimum £10m).

Good Morning Ryan,

Thank you for your email and approaching us first before taking on the work. This work should be fine for the town council to contract out however there are a few points that need to be observed when working with highway electrical equipment that I have highlighted below. Another issue to be aware of when painting columns is to make sure that the doors to the inside of the column are not completely painted over, if they paint over where the door makes contact with the rest of the column the paint work could be damaged when removing the doors for inspection/fault finding.

Safe Interaction – First Contact

There are a number of factors that can render an electrical installation dangerous on first contact :

- Loose line conductor or terminal touching exposed conductive parts
 - As a result of impact damage (RTC) or vandalism
 - As a result of life expired cutout
- Wrong polarity in an existing installation
 - Installed incorrectly by 3rd party – Initial Verification not carried out
- Wrong polarity on the DNO network (PME/CNE/TNC)
 - Reversed polarity – causing linked earthed and bonded exposed conductive parts to become live to touch
 - Loss of neutral conductor – causing linked earthed and bonded exposed conductive parts to act as a live conductor

Indications of reversed polarity:

- Dry Area around column or structure
- Steaming or heating of area around column
- Boiling noise coming from inside column or structure

Never touch any exposed conductive part (metallic) without first proving it is safe to touch



Mitigation measures, such as 'Please drive carefully' and advisory '40mph signs' will be erected along the diversion routes.

Traffic along the diversion route will be monitored to identify any issues / additional mitigation measures that may need to be considered.

Emergency Services (Police / Fire / Ambulance)

All traffic (including Emergency Service vehicles) travelling in the area to utilise the appropriate diversion route(s).

Holyhead Port

I would be grateful if you could inform ferry traffic of these proposed closures and advise all vehicles to drive safely along the diversion route.

Additional information

Liaison with Welsh Government Orders Branch regarding Traffic Orders has been undertaken.

Co-ordination with NMWTRA and Local Authority Streetworks Managers regarding all aspects of the works (including suitability of diversion route) has been undertaken.

Full consideration has been given to the impact of the work on road users, residents and work force e.g. Type of temporary traffic management (Full road closures with local diversions, contra flow, lane closures etc. road space, date of works, time of works, other works etc.)

Information signs will be erected prior to the works advising the travelling public of the closure dates and times.

NMWTRA will distribute a letter to properties alongside the works area informing residents / businesses.

Arrangements will be put in place to allow customers/workers to access and leave the properties within the closure.

Co-ordination with National Highways/ UK Highways has been undertaken to ensure no other closures are being planned on neighbouring Trunk Road networks.

Winter Service Contractors (PA) will be notified (gritting actions are co-ordinated every night).
