


Shaping Conwy's Communities

Every community has the opportunity to develop their own Place Plan.

Place plans are done by communities for communities. They can focus on a Town or community council area, a single village or a group of villages.

You understand:

- your community
- the people
- the history
- what works – and what doesn't.



Set up a community area team – get your community involved – let them know what's happening. Tell local businesses, organisations, hold events, use social media. More people will be interested than you think.

**Shape the place you live.
Get involved in your
community's Place Plan.**

Find out more about your place – gather as much information as you can – talk to your community – hold events to find out what's important to people. You'll get a picture of what's needed, where and why.


Evaluate your place – draw out your Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats. Get people to talk to more people – include council members – tiny businesses – big businesses – young people – incomers and old timers. They'll say what they think and help your evaluation.


Draft your place plan – use your evidence to start your plan – agree a 'vision' – set out the goals – identify the priorities – map out the steps to get there. It may be hard work but it's worth it.

Agree and start your place plan – see your plan in action. Have a written agreement – set out roles and their responsibilities. Keep a check on what's happening – change parts of the plan if needed and keep involving people. You're shaping your community!

Mae pob cymuned yn cael y cyfle i ddatblygu eu Cynllun Lleoedd eu hunain.



Fe fyddan nhw'n dweud beth sydd ar eu meddwl a helpu eich gwerthusiad.
