Fireworks Specification

Abergele Town Council strives ensure any project it delivers is done so in line with the Well-Being Goals set out in the Well-Being and Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015. Fireworks can have a detrimental impact on the environment and Abergele Town Council are looking for a display that minimises such effects. Extra consideration needs to be taken into account as the launch site is a SSSI site.

1. Display design

Abergele Town Council require two Fireworks displays: one designed for children and a main display.

Children's Firework Display

- Quieter fireworks need to be used
- The display needs to be designed for children and those with audio sensory sensitivities
- Eco-friendly fireworks if possible
- Biodegradable fireworks is essential
- No music required
- 8 minute display

Main Display

- Biodegradable fireworks is essential
- Eco-friendly fireworks if possible
- The display needs to be suitable for an estimated footfall of 5000 people
- No music required
- 10 minute high energy display

2. Timings

12.00pm* - Contractors to arrive and set up displays (*at latest)

6.15pm - Children's Firework Display

7.30pm - Main Firework Display

3. Installation of display

No vehicular access is permitted onto the SSSI so the Contractor is required to transport the equipment and goods onto the beach in a manner that is least disruptive to the site's delicate environment.

Note: a safe access corridor from the hard standing for your vehicle to the set will allow for the trolling of the materials.

4. Clean up after display

Any debris from the displays will need clearing.
