610/23 Guest Speaker

The Chair welcomed Mr. Tom Brinicombe from MaresConnect to the meeting who informed the Council about the proposed MaresConnect electricity interconnector project between Ireland and North Wales. The aim of the project is to connect the electricity grid in Ireland with the National Grid in the United Kingdom. The landfall and converter station sites are not currently set in stone although it is likely the converter station will be in the Bodelwyddan area, with the landfall site options between Colwyn Bay and Abergele. The project will look to decrease the planning envelope for the converter station as much as possible during the tendering process. Council asked if this would provide employment or learning and development opportunities for the community. Mr. Brinicombe stated that transmission projects such as MaresConnect provides less benefit than generation projects, but it could provide local supply chain benefits and MaresConnect would be willing to listen to proposed local initiatives.

The Chair thanked Mr. Brinicombe for the information and for taking the time to speak with Council.
