**-It was RESOLVED to receive, approve and sign the Minutes of the Parks, Street Scene & CCTV Sub-Committee held on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2019.**

668/19 **Matters Arising**

Mr Vic Turner (CCBC) was welcomed to the meeting. Mr Turner thanked members for their interest in providing speed indicator signs in the community and gave Members and update on the Council's survey of all speed signs in the county with a view to enhancing a bulk buy of new equipment. It is hoped that the Abergele scheme will benefit from any savings to be made. Further discussion followed regarding bi-lingual signs.

The desired locations of the speed signs were determined on local maps and given to VT who will share with Highways. Purchase prices will be forwarded as soon as received.

*Cllr Baker left the meeting at this juncture.*

669/19 Eligible projects (Gele Ward), for submission to the 'Conwy High Street Project' grant awards scheme, were CONSIDERED. **Members discussed several ideas and it was RESOLVED to make applications for the following:**

- a) To install electric charger stations in Water Street and Market St car parks.
- b) To install a town centre map depicting short circular walks start and finish in the town centre

*Cllr Sam Rowlands left the room for the next item having declared an interest*

- c) An e-mail from Men's Shed was RECEIVED and CONSIDERED. Men's Shed are nearing the completion of the acquisition of new premises which will require renovation and felt that as a project this would qualify for the funding. Members of the Committee felt that as a constituted entity the Men's Shed could make a standalone application for funding from the Conwy High Street project. **It was RESOLVED to write to Men's Shed to inform them.**

*Cllr Sam Rowlands returned to the meeting*

670/19 The Local Places for Nature project initiated by Keep Wales Tidy was CONSIDERED. One of three starter packs is on offer to help create either a butterfly garden, a fruit garden or a wildlife habitat in a location in the community which is easily accessible to all. The Mayor and Cllr Frost had attended a meeting with Abergele District Action Group to discuss the feasibility of the options and locating the project in Pentre Mawr Park. **It was RESOLVED to pursue permission from CCBC to create a butterfly garden in Pentre Mawr Park using the starter pack on offer and to include ADAG, Incredible Edible and the local schools.**
