Ers 1980 mae Noson Allan wedi gweithio gyda channoedd o leoliadau cymunedol yn eu galluogi i hyrwyddo dros 11,000 o berfformiadau ledled Cymru.

Mae Noson Allan yn helpu drwy diddymu'r perygl ariannol. Mae'r broses yn syml a hawdd a gallwn ddarparu cyllid a thocynnau, ynghyd â chymorth ymarferol a chyngor, yn ogystal â llawer o argymhellion ar amrywiaeth enfawr o sioeau ar gyfer pob oedran o theatr a cherddoriaeth i ddawns a phypedau.

Y broses – yn syml:

- Cysylltwch â'r perfformiwr a lled gytuno ar ddyddiad.
- Ymgeisiwch i Noson Allan, ar-lein neu lenwch ffurflen archebu syml, o leiaf pedair wythnos cyn y digwyddiad – neu'n gynt os yn bosib.
- Noson Allan fydd yn talu ffi'r perfformiwr. Cewch y sioe am ffi lai ac mae modd gofyn i'ch awdurdod lleol warantu'r gost. Felly ni fyddwch ar eich colled.
- Cynhaliwch y digwyddiad, rhowch bosteri i fyny a hyrwyddwch y sioe yn eich cymuned, mwynhewch ac adroddwch yn ôl inni wedyn gan dalu'n ôl inni incwm y tocynnau a wnaethoch (hyd at fwyafswm o ffi'r perfformiwr).

Great shows on your doorstep

Are you a community group in Wales that would like to put on a professional show in your local area?

Since 1980 Night Out has worked with hundreds of community venues enabling them to promote over 11,000 performances throughout Wales.

Night Out helps to take away the headache of financial risk. It is simple and easy to use and can provide funding and tickets, together with practical help and advice, as well as lots of recommendations on a huge variety of shows for all ages from theatre and music to dance and puppetry.

How it works – simplified:

- Get in touch with the performer, pencil in a date.
- Apply to Night Out either online or fill out the simple booking form, applying at least four weeks before the event but preferably much earlier.
- Night Out will pay the performer fee and you get the show at a reduced rate which can be guaranteed by your local authority, thus taking away the financial risk.
- You put on the event, put up posters and promote it to your local community, have a great time and then report back after – paying back the ticket income made (up to a maximum of the performer fee).
