Llangollen International Musical Eisteddfod

Preparations are well underway for the 2022 Llangollen International Musical Eisteddfod and I am writing to you as part of our annual fundraising appeal to Local Authorities, Town and Community Councils.

We are immensely appreciative of the support we have received in the past and respectfully ask if you would consider supporting us again in 2022.

Llangollen Eisteddfod's rich heritage extends back to the unique innovation of the founders in 1947, who saw the festival as a means of using the arts to bring different peoples together in a spirit of peace and friendship. The Eisteddfod has always been a community led initiative and continues on this basis with the support of some 800 volunteers. Bringing significant community benefits, the event attracts around 4000 competitors each year and audiences of around 30,000 throughout the week. This brings economic benefits to the area while the festival is taking place, but also enhances the tourism profile of the region throughout the year.

2022 will see some exciting changes to the Eisteddfod, with the outdoor field site re-designed, with a strong visual identity which immediately draws visitors into a vibrant festival atmosphere. The site will remain open until 10pm, with free events taking place around the field (provided by Village Circus and Articulture Wales), as well as food, bars, live music and a new in-the-round space for spoken word events, comedy and debate, providing plenty of social opportunities. This fresh approach should attract new audiences to the festival to experience a more contemporary side of Welsh art.

As well as a number of collaborations with arts organisations and charities across NE Wales, we'll also present the first in what we intend to be a longer-term partnership with Llangollen Fringe Festival – celebrating Llangollen Eisteddfod's 75th anniversary, and the Fringe's 25th anniversary. With this revived artistic approach, we can celebrate our heritage, but also set out our stall as a contemporary meeting place for the best of Welsh and international culture in all its forms.

We hope that you can continue to support us both financially and ideologically in any way that you can to help us continue our important work.
