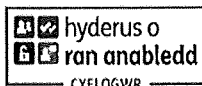

As part of the phased approach to putting in place the legislative framework within which Corporate Joint Committees (CJCs) will operate, the Minister for Finance and Local Government is launching a consultation on the next set of general regulations – **the Corporate Joint Committee (General) (Wales) Regulations 2022.**

The six week technical consultation on the draft general regulations builds on the comprehensive consultation undertaken in October 2020 which considered the general approach to the development of the legislative framework for CJCs and the consultation on the draft Corporate Joint Committee (General) (No.2) Wales Regulations in July 2021.

We wish to seek your views on next stage of the approach to the development of the wider legislative framework and application of specific elements of that framework. In particular, the regulations being consulted on will provide for:

- conduct of members of a CJC
- arrangements in the event that a member of the Mid Wales, North Wales, South East or South West Wales is suspended.
- the power to trade and undertake commercial activity
- further financial matters in relation to CJCs
- legal proceedings
- matters relating to records, documents and notices
- further provision on staffing and workforce
- a small number of miscellaneous provisions including a duty to prepare a constitution and provision in relation to handling of information and land held by a CJC

The consultation also seeks views on a number of areas which are intended to be provided for in the Corporate Joint Committee (General) (Wales) Regulations 2022. These include:

- issues in relation to the qualification and disqualification of members and officer of CJCs
