Good morning Cllr Wood

I had a meeting with Helen from Creu Conwy this morning with regard to hosting events and the information that she provided was very useful with regard to any planned events that the Community or Town Council may wish to host in the future.

Firstly, that there is the newly formed Town Team which aim to bring together volunteers and the businesses in order to facilitate such events. 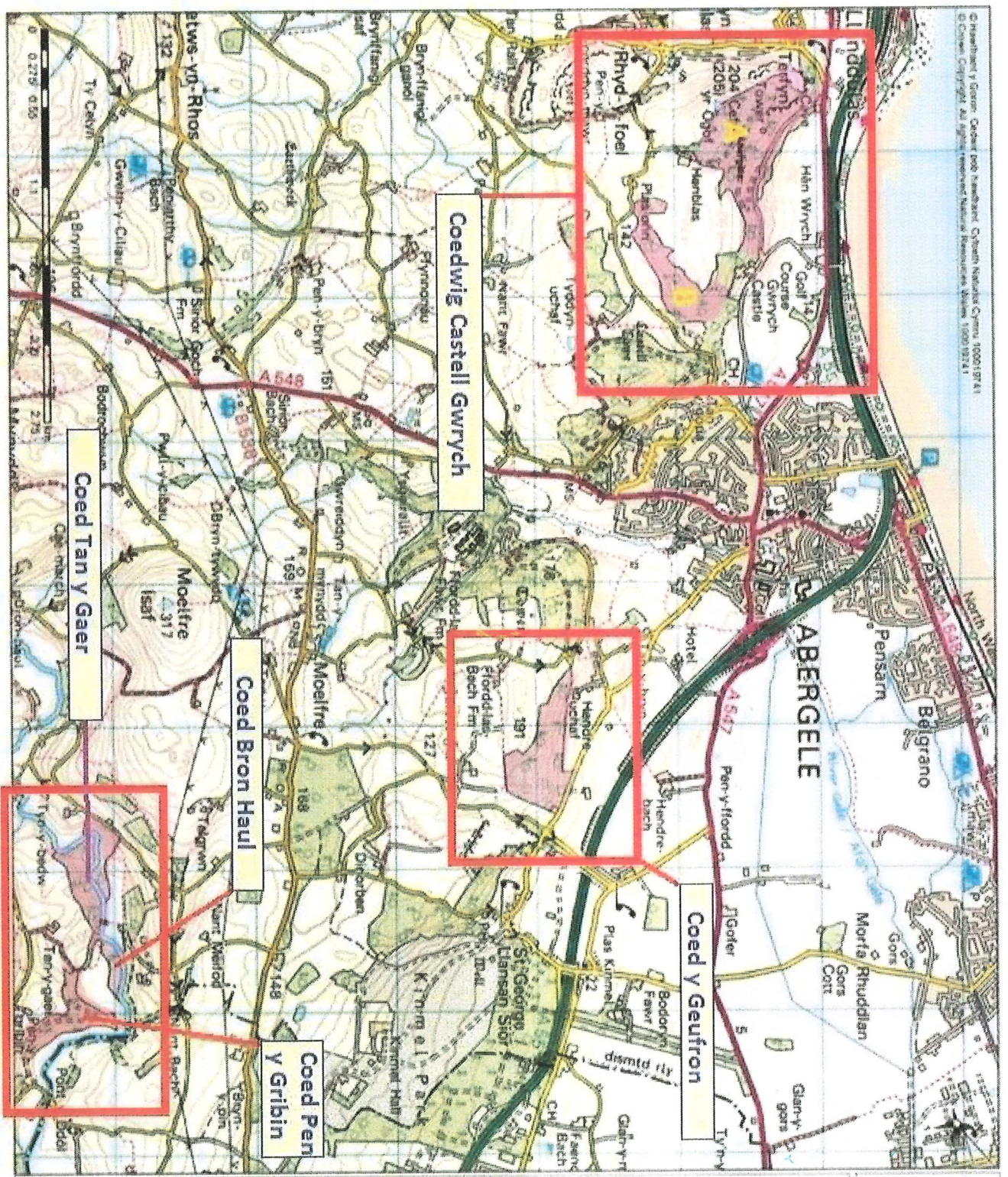

Morning Jesse,

That would be fantastic to bring up if you can.

Do you remember who did the presentation on One Voice Wales, I would love to have a look at what they have done?

Things to highlight at the working group:

- The Common Swift has been officially red listed in Wales and the UK.
- LPfN Conwy has recognised this and has prioritised funding this year to support local populations. Causes of their decline are a result of; habitat loss, unstable food (loss of insects) and climate change (migrations disruption)
- 70 IMPECKABLE double and four chambered fibre glass swift boxes have been purchased
- Current partners agreed to host Swift Boxes on their properties; Fire Service, NHS, CBCC, NWH, Sign Sight Sound

### **How we hope to achieve a better space for swifts.**

- We are using modern data from COFNOD to allocate boxes where recent colonies have been identified.
- LPfN focuses on the creation of habitat for pollinators across the county, both to support greater biodiversity but also a food source for swifts.

### **Maintenance and Important notes.**

- Swifts are 'self-cleaning' and physically remove any material from the boxes and distribute in the air just before their migration back down to continental Africa. There is no mess.
- These boxes must be installed at a height of 4.5m and above in a North Easterly/Westerly direction in order for them to nest.
- IMPECKABLE boxes last **50 years.**
- **Boxes will be installed by Western Platforms contractors on a suitable date before the end of LPfN 22-23, preferably Christmas time.**
- There are no additional costs attached 😊 All will be supported by LPfN.

I have supplied pictures of the exact boxes purchased in-situ (Werner Mertz Rhineland – white boxes). We have the boxes already and have been delivered to Tan y Llan.

If you need any more information off me please just let me know! Not only ATC, if you can think of any groups that may benefit from these boxes just let me know.
